6 Considerations for Arena Design

Building a riding arena represents a significant financial investment for any equine facility, but with careful planning and installation, it is likely to become one of the farm's most important assets. A successful arena plan should consider six critical variables—riding discipline, size, placement, drainage, base, and footing. Carefully assessing your individual situation and consulting with experts like the staff at Premier Equestrian will help ensure that the final result meets the unique needs of both your program and your budget.

1. What discipline(s) are you building for?

The needs of pleasure riding vary greatly from those of high-performance dressage or jumper riding. Understanding the demands for who will be using the arena is an important step in choosing the best match in each of the remaining categories.

“Not every arena is suitable for every single discipline,” says Mark Neihart, Premier Equestrian CEO and co-founder. “The surface interacts differently with different disciplines.”

Dressage horses require grip and stability, while jumping horses need a surface that is firm enough to push off yet cushioned enough to absorb the impact of landing. Horses in disciplines such as reining need footing that is loose enough to allow them to slide. Knowing exactly who and what you are designing for is critical before making any other decisions.



2. What Size Should My Arena Be?

When it comes to arenas, one size does not fit all. Consider the number of horses that will use the arena at one time and the amount of space available. A competition sized dressage arena is 20 meters by 60 meters (12,915 sqft, not including a perimeter track) while a jumping arena may need to be 100' by 200' (20,000 sqft) to accommodate a full course.

3. Where Should I Build My Arena?

Perhaps one of the most critical variables to consider is the placement of the arena on your property. Some things that will influence your decision include accessibility (to barns, to water, to electricity) and proximity to high traffic areas. From an arena designer's perspective, the ideal location not only meets all of the needs listed above, but it is also already somewhat flat.

The topography of your land will determine how much cutting or filling an excavator must do to prepare the site for your arena. This preparation can become a major line item in the budget if significant site work is required. That's not to say it is impossible to create a flat space out of an existing hill, but a larger percentage of the budget will be absorbed here rather than starting with a flat location.

4. Water Flows and Water Falls

Drainage problems are a common complaint about existing arenas, and this is often because it was not considered during planning. Determine where water is already moving naturally. In general, flatter areas tend to collect water, while hills and slopes will direct water.

The ideal location for your arena is an area from which water readily drains away. If this is not possible, most drainage issues can be addressed through a combination of excavation work and the selection of an appropriate base material.

5. How Do I Choose the Right Base?

The type of base is critical to a successful arena because it provides a solid and consistent foundation for the footing. There are many options for base materials, and the right one for your specific situation will depend on the placement and drainage needs of your site as well as your budget.

Many arenas are successfully built upon a simple compacted base. This economical option requires stone dust and screenings or road base, which is wetted down and compacted with a vibrating roller. Other arenas are built on a free-draining base, which combines rock with a geotextile to promote drainage.

An additional option is the Arion Ebb & Flow Arena, where the arena is built over a liner pan and pipe array from which water can readily flow in and out. The system is electronically controlled to maintain a consistent level of moisture, wetting the footing from below and eliminating the need for sprinklers. After heavy rain, excess water is collected in the liner pan and released through a sophisticated drainage system. ([Learn more on pg. 26](#))

6. What Type of Footing Should I Use?

While all of the preceding considerations for arena design are critical to ultimate success, when it comes to the horse, perhaps no other component is more important than the selection of the footing itself.

There are many footing options, ranging from simple sand to synthetic fabrics to waxed footing. There are two important considerations when selecting: availability of water and the type of sand available in your area. The correct sand is critical and can be difficult to source. There are over 10,000 types of sand used in the U.S. alone for different purposes, so be careful in your choices.

"If you go down to the local rock quarry and say, 'I'm building a horse arena,' I guarantee the guy will say, 'yeah, I have horse arena sand,'" says Mark Neihart. "That guy doesn't know anything about horses, just that somebody bought that sand for a horse arena. So be careful."

Sand choice is perhaps one of the most expensive mistakes made when building arenas. To avoid this, [get a free arena sand analysis](#) from the experts at Premier Equestrian to determine the best type of sand for your facility and for the type of footing you want. The quality of the sand you choose will ultimately play a critical role in the performance of your arena and dust levels.

Once you know your sand, you can then select from various footing amendments including rubber, textiles, or other well established additives. Amendments are carefully chosen to complement your available sand, giving cushion to harder varieties and assisting with moisture retention and stability for others.

Final Thoughts

While the elements in designing a great riding surface are no secret, it is easy to make costly mistakes. *Underfoot* is an arena building and design guide published by the United States Dressage Federation and edited by the experts at Premier Equestrian. 

5 Things You Should Know Before Purchasing Textile Footing

There are a variety of horse footing products on the market today, but not all footing products are created equal. Before you take the plunge and purchase a footing product for your horse arena, it's crucial to educate yourself about the footing product's ingredients, origins, storage, usage, and maintenance. Read more about the importance of these five factors and what to look for in a quality footing product.

1. Know what's in your footing product

Just as you read the ingredients on food labels at a grocery store or cosmetic products at a beauty store, you should also investigate the key ingredients used to create a textile footing product before purchasing it. High-quality horse arena footing, like all Premier Equestrian Textile Footing Products, will have an SDS Report (Safety Data Sheet) available. The SDS Report will tell you what "ingredients" are used to create a specific footing product, and whether those ingredients are hazardous and include post-consumer waste or industrial waste.

"There's no footing police out there, so we're doing our part to ensure that the footing products we offer are products we can stand by," explains Heidi Zorn, president of Premier Equestrian. "We have

very high standards; we only sell footing products that we would personally ride on, and we only offer textile footing products that have an SDS Report." These textile footing products include Premier ProTex, Premier ArenaAid, Premier Athletex, and Premier All Purpose. When getting quotes, always compare the amount of footing you are quoting by pounds. Some companies quote bales—this is a clever way to charge you more and give you less material.

2. Know the origins of your footing product

Some footing companies utilize post-consumer waste (products recycled after consumer use), but all Premier Equestrian Textile Footing Products are made from new materials only using industrial waste (trimmings off newly made materials). "We use industrial trimmings for our textile footing products because they're safer and better for the horse and rider," explains Zorn. "Many of our competitors sell footing products made with post-consumer waste, which could be contaminated and ultimately dangerous."

Arena footing products made with post-consumer waste can contain chemicals, bacteria, viruses, and a host of other contaminants.

Premier Equestrian recycles their footing products to high standards of quality, and all Premier Textile Footing Products have SDS Reports, as previously noted. “We are the true textile footing supplier with safety and function at the forefront of all our materials,” adds Zorn. “We’re always looking out for our customers and the overall health of the horse.”

3. Know how your footing product is stored & packaged

Before purchasing a footing product, ask the supplier how their footing products are stored and packaged. If a footing product is packaged in large batches that aren’t stored properly mold and bacteria can quickly set in. The result? Not only will this make your footing product more difficult to spread because it’s all stuck together, but, worse, when you go to ride on your new footing you could be riding on a moldy surface, which is hazardous to both horse and rider.

Additionally, it’s often cheaper for companies to store equestrian footing products in a non-climatized warehouse, and if footing products aren’t stored properly you may be charged for excess humidity and water weight when your footing product is shipped. You can rest assured that Premier Equestrian arena footing products are properly stored and packaged. “We store all Premier Equestrian footing products in acclimatized spaces,” notes Zorn. “Premier footing products are wrapped at all times to ensure they arrive to clients in the very best shape, never wet nor damaged.”

4. Know what sand is best for your footing product

Sand is the key ingredient in all good horse arena footing. Sand qualities affect the performance of your footing, such as the tightness, looseness, softness, hardness, and dustiness. Whether you’re purchasing a footing product for a new arena or rehabilitating an existing surface, keep in mind that the wrong sand can create problems and add to your expense over time. 
Maintain Your Investment

Even with the best sand and footing additive, proper maintenance is vital to the success of your arena and to the performance of your horses. At Premier Equestrian, we believe that understanding your sand and footing is the first step to helping you better maintain an optimal surface for your horses.

Understanding Your Sand

Well Graded Sand




One of the first things we analyze in an equestrian arena is the gradation of the sand particles. This refers to the range of particle sizes. A well-graded sand will have a combination of different sized particles. The variation of small particles fills the voids between the larger particles, stabilizing the surface from shifting and rolling.

Sand that has either no grading or is gap graded will have severe separation of layers that are difficult to mix, and the surface can be very loose and unstable.

Particle Size and Grooming

Lack of a grooming program enables the different sand particle sizes and additives to separate into layers. Vibrations and movement cause a phenomenon known as granular segregation, or “The Brazil Nut Effect,” where the largest particles end up on the surface.

Imagine a container of cereal. Initially your bowls are filled with consistently-sized pieces, but near the end of the box the pieces get



smaller and smaller. Your arena is like that container. Due to constant vibrations and movement on the surface, the small particles settle to the base through the voids of the larger particles, while the larger particles migrate toward the top of the surface.

When the particles separate, the top layer can become unstable and the lower layer may compact. Regularly grooming your arena combats the separation of layers and keeps particles and additives evenly mixed.

Maintaining Additives

Each material making up a footing additive has a specific function to enhance sand qualities, and they are designed to be well incorporated into the sand. Grooming keeps footing additives and sand mixed so that the mechanics of the footing matrix and the quality of the surface are not compromised.

Water

Water adds beneficial stabilization and grip, keeps dust out of the air, and most importantly acts as a binder. Keeping the surface damp when grooming will help the sand and additives stick together so they blend appropriately. Even without an additive, sand arenas will always perform better when watered.

Your watering routine will depend on your watering system, traffic, climate, indoor vs. outdoor, and the amount of moisture you naturally have (humidity, rainfall, none).

A water wagon is very efficient and there is less water waste compared to sprinklers. Watering the evening before gives it time to perk down thru which helps with water retention. If you have sprinklers, make sure they are staggered for better coverage. Water when there is little to no wind to reduce over spray and water loss.

Great arena footing doesn't come from just installing new sand or a brand-name additive. Creating an in-depth arena maintenance program is the best way to make sure that the arena of your dreams will last for years to come.

Blazing Trails

How Premier Equestrian Changed the Dressage Arena Industry

It's been said that necessity is the mother of invention. Such was the case for Premier Equestrian President Heidi Zorn when she developed the signature dressage arena that would launch her company and help modernize the dressage industry as we now know it.

Inspiration first struck in 1999 when Zorn wanted a dressage arena. Back then, most dressage arenas were either very expensive or poorly made. It wasn't uncommon to see arenas constructed of chains or cinder blocks, which were dangerous for horses—so much so, that the United States Equestrian Federation eventually banned these types of arenas from competition. A frustrated Zorn did what many entrepreneurs had done before her: she rolled up her sleeves and started designing her own version.

"The price was a barrier; they were all \$5,000 to \$6,000, which was out of my budget," recalls Zorn. "Also, the choice of materials wasn't good—horses were getting caught or cut in the chains, or they were kicking the cinder blocks and getting injured." Zorn knew she could do better. She developed the idea for an affordable, safe, and stylish dressage arena made from lightweight but sturdy PVC. The arena was portable and easy to assemble, and it could be anchored for a more permanent installation. She named it the Classic Dressage Arena™ (see pg 43) and sold it for \$1,500—and with that, Premier Equestrian was born in 2000.

"It was the first dressage arena of its kind," says Zorn. "We launched Premier Equestrian with that product. It was a total game-changer for the dressage market. We offered safe and affordable arenas for both high-end facilities and competitors, as well as casual, backyard riders like me."

As word traveled about the Classic Dressage Arena and the popularity of Premier's signature design grew among the equestrian community, Zorn teamed up with now CEO Mark Neihart to grow the company and expand their line of dressage arena equipment.

The Sundance and Pyramid Dressage Arenas™ came shortly after. These

utilized a molded polyethylene cone with a new set-in trough design to support the rails. The base cone is virtually indestructible, stacks and stores easily, will not fade or discolor in sunlight, and never needs painting—just a few of the many benefits of a dressage arena built from Polyethylene and PVC.



The Sundance and Pyramid arenas include bottom plates, which allow the cones to be filled



with sand, which helps stabilize an arena in up to 60 MPH winds. This feature, along with a new aerodynamic design and rounded, tapered corners provided a significant improvement.

"We saw a huge need in multi-rail arenas," recalls Zorn. So we developed a glamorous yet extremely safe multi rail arena called the Brentina Arena "Before the Brentina Arena, multi-rail panels were riveted together and horses were getting caught and tangled in them—horses would kick a panel and get stuck, and then panic running off with a panel stuck to their foot, which is extremely dangerous for both horses and riders."

The Brentina Arena, features a unique quick-release design: if a horse kicks through the rails, they will pop out, ensuring no horse will ever get tangled in this design. "It's such a safe and beautiful arena," says Zorn. USA Dressage Coach Debbie McDonald was so inspired by the design, and such a huge fan of the safety benefits, that she allowed Premier to use her famous mare Brentina's name for the arena.


Debbie McDonald isn't the only fan—Premier Equestrian's Sundance and Brentina Dressage Arenas are currently used for competition at these venues; 2023 FEI World Cup in Omaha, Adequan® Global Dressage Festival in Wellington, Pan American Games, World Equestrian Center, Dressage at Devon, and Desert International Horse Park, just to name a few.
