

Horse Solarium Instructions



What's Included:

- 12 shatter-resistant infrared heat lamps
- Ample chain for over head hanging
- Long power lead with L5-30P plug

Solariums are fully PAT tested.

Requires a 30-Amp breaker with a NEMA L5-30R outlet receptacle.



Hanging Instructions:

- **1.** Unwrap all transport wrapping and ties.
- **2.** Turn arm into parallel position on center rail and tighten wing nut.
- 3. Turn each arm end into position and tighten wing nuts.
- **4.** Hang unit with chains provided to a safe overhead structure.
- **5.** Screw lamps into brass holders.
- **6.** Adjust unit to required height.
- **7.** The recommended height is 24 inches (600mm) from the bottom of the outer lamp to horse withers.
- **8.** Plug into an outlet and you are ready to go.

Usage Instructions:

- 10-15 minute sessions prior to work will help loosen up muscles.
- 20-25 minute sessions after work will relax muscles, decrease soreness, and aid in recovery.
- Use the solarium to dry a wet horse from turnouts or provide light exposure during winter months.
- Always monitor your horse for signs of discomfort.
